5. New Business – Discussion and/or action on the following:

A. Purchase Pre-bid Backhoe-David Garcia/Jack Owen

Councilman Barcelo motioned to purchase the pre-bid backhoe without a down payment, interest rate of 3.2 percent for 84 months, and financing \$95,554 plus tax. Seconded by Councilman Romero. Motion passed.

Vice Mayor Wickham requested that all training hours get documented.

B. Proposed site of Heli-pad Mayor Barcelo

Mayor Barcelo stated that there has been a misunderstanding incident regarding the site of the proposed helicopter landing pad. The incident is under investigation and could possibly have placed the Town in jeopardy. He also stated that an individual, proposing the site, stated in the April 13, 2012 meeting that neighbors around the site had been notified and all were in agreement for the helicopter pad but this was not true. Mayor Barcelo recommended abandoning the proposed site on Rash Road and research another location more suitable.

Mr. Stewart, a property owner near the proposed site, state that he was not in agreement with a helicopter pad being placed in the location because of the possible interference on his property. He also stated that some of the vegetation on his property had been destroyed.

Councilwoman Medina motioned to not have a helicopter pad at proposed Rash Road and Wasko subdivision site. Seconded by Vice Mayor Wickham. Motion passed.

C. CDBG/CAAG Project on new wording from 10/25 workshop

Vice Mayor Wickham motioned to table this item. Seconded by Councilman Barcelo. Motion passed.

6. Council Comments

Vice Mayor Wickham state that there had been positive comments from all the departments.



Councilman Barcelo motioned for adjournment. Seconded by Councilwoman Medina. Motion passed.


The meeting adjourned at 6:25 p.m.
