He said that a citizen of Mammoth, Clifford Deathridge, has been instrumental in trying to bring business to Mammoth, and that you don't hear about it because the [work] is not done. Mayor Barcelo stated that we will take the Town forward, but it will take time.

Councilman Brewer thanked all the people who have been calling and coming by his house, and he stated "I'm here anytime you need me." He also said his phone number is 487-2446, call anytime.

Councilman [Juan] Barcelo stated that most of the Council is trying to do betterment for the Town, while others are doing their own thing.


Vice Mayor Wickham thanked Planning and Zoning and Lynn Zeiler for the newsletter.
