Minutes of a Regular Council Meeting of the Mammoth Town Council held March 21, 2013, pursuant to the notice required by law.

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4. Call to Public

Rudy Romo stated that on behalf of the Mammoth Fire Department he felt that it would be a mistake for the Council to allow another fire department come in to Town.

Frances Amparano stated that she is proud of the Fire Department in how they reacted to the fire at Gonzales' house. She also stated that even the fire department's secretary was at the fire handing out water.

Billie Bailey stated that she lives just above the location of the fire [from the night before] and asked why the closest fire department wasn't called because the local fire department ran out of water and had to wait 20-25 minutes for someone to get here and turn on water.

Ernest Busatamante stated that he wanted to state [on record] that he supported Redhawk Mine.

Vice Mayor Wickham motioned to approve the Consent Agenda. A second was made by Councilwoman Medina. Roll Call vote: Vice Mayor Wickham-Yes; Councilman (Juan) Barcelo-Yes; Mayor (Alvaro) Barcelo-Yes; Councilman Brewer-No; Councilwoman Medina-Yes. Motion passed 4-Yes votes to 1-No vote.

Vice Mayor Wickham motioned to table this item. A second was made by Councilman Barcelo. Motion passed.

Councilwoman Medina motioned to table items 6. (A) and (B). A second was made by Vice Mayor Wickham. Motion passed.

- D. Rights to the Little League Field for the 2013-14 Season – Ralph Valencia

Councilman Barcelo motioned to allow the little League and Senior League exclusive rights to the fields for the 2013 season. A second was made by Councilwoman Medina. Motion passed.

- E. Government Membership Fee-Edward Farrell, Pinal Partnership Vice President

Mr. Farrell did not show for the meeting.

Councilman Barcelo motioned to table. A second was made by Vice Mayor Wickham. Motion passed.

- F. Copper Community Hospice – Margo Badilla

Ms. Badilla made a presentation to the Council and the Citizens about the services that Copper Community Hospice offers, including specialization in “end of life”, they visit patients and families in need for their services, and they do not turn anyone down who may need their services.

Vice Mayor Wickham motioned to accept Ms. Bailey’s resignation from the Planning and Zoning Committee. A second was made by Councilwoman Medina. Motion passed.

- I. Planning and Zoning Updates and Recommendations- Debora Foster

Ms. Foster stated that the P&Z had a successful meeting [the night before this Council Meeting] and the committee discussed the clean-up around town to promote future growth.

Chairwoman Foster also stated that the committee recommended a variance for Mr. Jose Garcia who had erected a metal ramada without a proper permit.

Vice Mayor Wickham motioned to grant a variance to Mr. Garcia. A second was made by Councilman Barcelo. Motion passed.

- J. Advanced EMS for the Town of Mammoth-Bud Payne

Mr. Payne demonstrated equipment and made a brief presentation to the Council regarding emergency medical care for the Town of Mammoth.

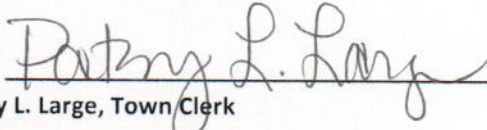
