



**TOWN OF MAMMOTH  
NOTICE OF A SPECIAL MEETING  
OF THE MAMMOTH TOWN COUNCIL  
FRIDAY, OCTOBER 25, 2013**

*NOTE: Councilman Brewer arrived at approximately 9:30 a.m. to check his mailbox. He continued to wait outside the Town Hall, returning periodically checking the time on the clock in the Council Chambers. Council Members present and waiting in the Council Chambers were Mayor Barcelo, Councilman Barcelo and Vice Mayor Medina. Just before 10:00 a.m. the Council was notified by Councilman Romero, that he had worked graveyard shift and would be running a few minutes late. At this time, no residents were present for the Council Meeting. The Mayor and Council Members present agreed to wait for Councilman Romero's arrival. Shortly afterward Councilman Brewer, once again, returned to the Council Chambers, looked at the clock, not saying anything to anyone, then exited again. Upon the arrival of Councilman Romero, Mayor Barcelo asked if Councilman Brewer was still in the parking lot of the Town Hall. Councilman Romero stated that no one was in the parking lot. Later that day the Mayor was advised by a resident who had been waiting for the meeting to begin [in the parking lot] that Councilman Brewer advised the waiting citizens that there was not a quorum for the meeting. A quorum is 4 Council Members, seated in the chambers were three and Councilman Brewer would have made 4. Not knowing that the Council was waiting for the arrival of the 5<sup>th</sup> councilman, Brewer took it upon himself to announce "no meeting because no quorum", assuming he would have been the 4<sup>th</sup> member.*

**5. New Business – Discussion and/or action on the following:**

**A. Storage fees for the Impound Yard – Chief Marty McIntosh**

**Chief McIntosh thanked the Council for attending the meeting, stating that this meeting is very important to him. He advised the Council that the Public Works Department is preparing the impound yard for seized and impounded vehicles. He explained that this is another revenue source for the Town, and would like the Council to consider passing a resolution or ordinance at the next regular meeting.**

**B. Mammoth Police Canine Program- Chief McIntosh**

Chief McIntosh advised the Council that he had spoken to Sgt. Danny Lopez of the Pinal County Sheriff's Department Canine Unit regarding a single purpose dog for the Mammoth Police Department. He stated that Pinal County Sheriff's Department is willing to help in acquiring a good dog and offered free training for the Officer and canine. Chief McIntosh asked the Council to approve the Canine Program so we can proceed with plans.

Councilman Barcelo motioned to allow Chief McIntosh proceed with the single purpose canine program. A second was made by Councilman Romero. Motion passed.

**C. Approval to allow CPS Agency to park cars in the impound yard – Chief McIntosh**

Chief McIntosh advised the Council that CPS had contacted him and asked if the Town would allow them [CPS] to park the government vehicles in the Town yard for security purposes. He asked the Council to approve this item.

Vice Mayor Medina motioned to allow CPS park their vehicles in the Police impound yard. A second was made by Councilman Barcelo. Motion passed.

**D. Jackets for the Public Works Department Employees –Pablo Rodriguez**

David Garcia, Public Works Director, stated that Pablo Rodriguez had priced Retro Reflective Jackets & Liners at the rate of \$37.95 each. He also stated that the jackets normally sell for approximately \$80-90 each. The jackets are for safety purposes as well as for cold weather.

Councilman Barcelo motioned to allow the Public Works Department purchase safety jackets for the employees. A second was made by Councilman Romero. Motion passed.

Mayor Barcelo stated that this was a good meeting without any negative Council comments.


Councilman Barcelo thanked Councilman Romero for attending the meeting after working a 12 hour shift.
