5. New Business – Discussion and/or Action on the Following:

A. Canvass Votes for the 2014 General Election-Adopt Resolution No.2016 – Patsy Large

Councilman Brewer motioned to canvass the votes per the county. A second was made by Councilwoman Wickham. Motion passed.

B. Swear in newly elected Councilmembers: Bob Sloan & Don Jones-Patsy Large

Councilman Brewer motioned to have Councilwoman Wickham as Vice Mayor. A second was made by Councilman Sloan. Motion passed.

D. Appoint Commissioners-Mayor

Mayor Jones appointed Councilman Brewer as Public Works commissioner and Bob Sloan as Police Commissioner.

E. Council Comments

Councilman Brewer stated that there has been an issue up at the community center, that it has been stated that some of the newly elected officers called up there and ran the seniors out. He said that he knows for a fact that did not happen. He said we will not do what they did to the other group. He said he seen them leaving with their hot meals in their hands and tears in their eyes, we will not do that to that group. He said it is not their intentions and never said it was, in fact he said it adamantly to everybody that they would not run anybody out of the community center. Thank you.

Vice mayor Wickham stated that there has been a lot of negative stuff that has been breaking the town apart and she is hoping that they will work together. She said a lot of things have been said that she has done and written and she said she has not done anything. She stated that she has been the one out there working in the past few years, trying to get money for our town. She said she will continue to do whatever she can to help the town. She said it has been on her dime and her time. There have only been a couple instances where the town has reimbursed her while out for official business. She said she will do whatever is in her power to help the new mayor and the new council. Mayor Jones stated that he wants more people at the meeting. He stated that he wants everyone to get to know him and get different ideas from the public. Mayor Jones wants any ideas to be put on the agenda.

Town Clerk Large shared the order of the new agenda. She also said she has a request from NCS to have a discussion to answer any questions regarding grant money and water system. She stated the reason for that is because he has been getting threatening phone calls. She also stated that the county is working with the library to get the web page up again.
