FEBRUARY 12, 2013**

Minutes of the Regular Meeting for the Mammoth Town Council held February 12, 2013, pursuant to the notice required by law.

1. Call to Order

Mayor Barcelo called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

2. Pledge of Allegiance

4. Call to Public

John Hernandez, Reporter for the Miner Newspaper, asked if the purchase of the property at 337 had been closed and what was the Town going to do with the property.

Patsy Large, Town Clerk, said yes the Town now owns the property and that the Town will continue to rent it for the time being.

5. Executive Session – Pursuant to A.R.S. 38-431.03.3A

Vice Mayor Wickham motioned to go into Executive Session with all the Council, Department Heads and the Attorney for no longer than 45 minutes. A second was made by Councilwoman Medina. Motion passed.

7:07 p.m. - The Council, Department Heads and Attorney went into Executive Session.

7:43 p.m. – Councilman Barcelo motioned to adjourn the Executive Session. A second was made by Councilwoman Medina. Motion passed.

7:45 p.m. – Mayor Barcelo called the regular session to order.

6. New Business-Discussion and/or action on the following:

- A. Public Works Department –The employment practices and job assignments –  
Councilman Brewer

Councilman Brewer motioned to table this item for the next meeting. A second was made by Vice Mayor Wickham. Motion passed.

Vice Mayor Wickham motioned to discuss item 6(E) Relocation of the Helicopter Landing Zone for emergency purposes, prior to Item 6(B). A second was made by Councilman Barcelo. Motion passed.

(6-E) Relocation of the Helicopter Landing Zone for emergency purposes – David Garcia, PW Director

David Garcia, Public Works Director, stated that he needs the space at the cemetery and would like to move the helicopter landing zone to the soccer field, and will be moving the soccer field next to the softball field.

Mr. Rick Sanchez, Interim Administrator of the Volunteer Fire department, state that the fire department has no objection to the move. And he stated that he felt this was a logical move and would be best for the community.

PW Director David Garcia stated that he would move the wind sock to the new location.

Vice Mayor Wickham motioned to move the helicopter landing zone to the soccer field permanently and the soccer field would be moved next to the softball field. A second was made by Councilman Barcelo. Motion passed.

- B. Speaker Cards for the Council Meetings – What information should be requested prior to allowing someone to speak at Council meetings. – Vice Mayor Wickham

Vice Mayor Wickham stated that she has attended different meetings where speaker cards are required and is interested in having them available for the public to speak. But wants the public to know that the Council is not taking anything away from them.

Vice Mayor Wickham stated that the Council would leave it up to the Town Manager as to which we would have speaker cards or a sign-in sheet for those who wish to speak.

- C. Create an Economic Development Board/Committee – Vice Mayor Wickham

Vice Mayor Wickham stated that she would like to create an economic development board/committee, and would like to post the announcements around Town, requesting letters of interest along with resumes. Would like to post for at least one month and create a five member board.

- D. Farmer's Market/Swap Meet-Allow the Senior Citizens sponsor a monthly Farmer's Market/Swap Meet – Vice Mayor Wickham

Councilwoman Medina stated that the Senior Citizens would like to sponsor a monthly Farmer's Market/Swap Meet.

Vice Mayor Wickham thanked Lynn Zeiler for contacting vendors for the swap meet.

Vice Mayor Wickham announced that the Town is sponsoring a free income tax preparation to be held every other Wednesday from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at the Town Hall. This would begin on Wednesday February 13, 2013. The public should call the Town Hall to make appointments.

Vive Mayor Wickham also announced that on Thursday, February 21, 2013 the Board of Supervisors will be holding a Public Hearing on marijuana at 9:00 a.m. in Florence.
