5. Consent Agenda:

A. Approval of minutes

7. Old Business—Discussion and/or Action on the Following:

A. Confiscated truck-Joe Brewer

Councilman Brewer stated that he could never get reports from the attorney, because the attorney couldn't get them from the county. He stated that the reports conflict each other and that is wrong. He said the dates are wrong on the reports from each report. He stated that he has read the reports and nowhere did he see that there were drugs in the vehicle.



- B. Discussion and consideration of ordinance No. 196 an Ordinance of the Town of Mammoth concerning recall from office and ineligibility of recall from running and being elected to office.

- C. Discussion and consideration of Ordinance No. 197 an Ordinance of the Town of Mammoth regulation use of ATV and off road vehicles in the Town limits.

Vice Mayor Wickham motioned to approve Ordinance No. 197. A second was made by Councilman Brewer. Motioned passed.

- D. Discussion and possible action to expand cemetery, and create interment area for nonresidents and create policy on fee for nonresidents.

Councilman Sloan motioned to authorize staff to explore costs and regulations to expand cemetery and create interment area for nonresidents and create policy on fee for nonresidents. A second was made by Councilman Brewer. Motion passed.

8. New Business-Discussion and/or action on the following:

- A. Check presentation for summer program and waste filtration system-Resolution Copper.

Dave Richins from Resolution Copper presented the town with a check for 9,226.50.

- B. Rescind motion returning confiscated truck to owner-Mayor Jones

Mayor Jones motioned to reconsider. A second was made by Vice Mayor Wickham. Motion passed. Councilman Sloan made a motion to rescind the vote. Vice Mayor Wickham second the motion. Motion passed.

- C. Research grant for a mini water park at the pool and renovation at the pool-Mayor Jones.

Mayor Jones stated he would like to upgrade the pool and get some funding to place some sprinklers, slide or water pads at the pool. Councilman Sloan made a motion to research a grant for a mini water park. A second was made by Vice Mayor Wickham. Motion passed.

- D. Little League and swimming pool concession stands (monies from stands)-Joe Brewer.

Councilman Brewer stated that he didn't know where the money was going for the little league concession stands and the money from the pool concession. Terry Rodriguez stated that the money

from the Little League stays with the league. The money pays for the utility bills, insurance, all-star entry, uniforms, patches, and paper work. Everything the league brings in they use the money to pay their bills. Vice Mayor Wickham stated that she spoke with Pablo about where the money was going from the swimming pool concession, and she stated that Pablo said he was using it for the wrestlers. Vice Mayor Wickham. Mayor Jones stated maybe in the future we could start renting out the concession stand for a rental fee.

E. VFW presentation concerning veteran's cemetery-Frances Wickham/Leandro Guillen.

Mr. Guillen stated that last year he brought it up to the old council that the VFW would be in charge of the old cemetery. That the cemetery plot would be free for the veteran and that the family would pay for the opening and closing. Mr. Guillen also stated that the veteran would have to be a resident of 5 or more years in order to receive the privilege. Mr. Guillen stated that it was approved and passed and they were waiting for the letter and they never received it. Mr. Cooper stated that he doesn't remember this coming to us this last year. He stated that he would have told the council that we can't give it to no one because its gifted property and no person would want it because they would have to establish a perpetual care fund with the state fund of real estate.

F. The Town of Mammoth operation of a fish pond.

Councilman Brewer stated we have a well and land that we are not using that we could use and make a pond. He stated that game and fish would stock the pond.

9. Council Comments

Councilman Sloan stated that we are improving gradually. He stated with staff and council working together we are getting things done. Vice Mayor stated Happy Father's Day!

10. Adjourn

Councilman Sloan motioned for adjournment. A second was made by Vice Mayor Wickham. Motion passed.
