NOTE 1 – SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The Annual Expenditure Limitation Report (AELR) is presented on the basis of accounting prescribed by the *Uniform Expenditure Reporting System* (UERS), as required by Arizona Revised Statutes Section 41-1279.07, and in accordance with the voter approved alternative expenditure limitation adopted May 18, 2010, as authorized by the Arizona Constitution, Article IX, Section 20(9).

In accordance with the UERS requirements, a note to the AELR is presented below for any exclusion claimed on Part II and each deduction or addition in the Reconciliation that cannot be traced directly to an amount reported in the fund financial statements. All references to financial statement amounts in the following notes refer to the Statement of Revenues, Expenditures, and Changes in Fund Balances for the Governmental Funds, Statement of Revenues, Expenses, and Changes in Fund Net Position for the Proprietary Funds, and the Statement of Cash Flows for the Proprietary Funds.

Using a voter approved alternative expenditure limitation, there are no constitutionally allowed exclusions available to the Town in determining the amount subject to the expenditure limitation. Therefore, there are no exclusions taken in Part II of the Annual Expenditure Limitation Report.
