Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-431.02(B), notice is hereby given to the members of the Town Council and to the general public that the Town Council will hold a Regular Town Council Meeting which is open to the public on Thursday, June 18, 2020 at the Mammoth Town Hall located at 125 North Clark Street, Mammoth, Arizona. The Town Council may hold an Executive Session, A.R.S. § 38-431.03(A)(3) and (4) for legal advice, which will not be open to the public, to discuss any Agenda items set forth below.

Due to the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic, which have prompted declarations of a public health emergency at both the state and federal levels, this meeting will be conducted using measures to protect public health. Members of the public are encouraged NOT TO ATTEND THE MEETING IN PERSON but instead to attend and listen to the meeting remotely by telephone.

Discussion and possible selection of a project for Fiscal Year 2020 CDBG Grant Funding.

Based on citizen input as well as local and state planning objectives several potential projects may be selected to be forwarded to the State of Arizona and Pinal County with a request for funding. A public hearing will be held at the Regular Town Council meeting on Thursday, June 18, 2020, at 7:00 p.m., at the Town Council Chambers located at 125 N. Clark St., Mammoth, Arizona, to discuss the potential projects. It is expected that the Town Council will select the final projects at this hearing and adopt applicable resolutions. The potential CDBG projects are named and described as follows:

The Town is proposing to spend this year's money to upgrade the Drinking Water Booster Station on Rash Road (across from Circle K) and install a SCADA System to help remotely monitor tank levels, pump status, flowrates, etc. The Booster Station is a critical element in the drinking water system and it has been the source of repeated problems because the equipment is outdated and becoming obsolete. The ability to remotely monitor the status of the booster station, the wells, and the storage tanks, will help identify and solve drinking water system issues more quickly and efficiently, minimizing the number and duration of water outages, and significantly reducing water loss. The Town will consider other CDBG proposals at this Public Hearing.
