4. **BUDGET PRESENTATION BY PAT WALKER CONSULTING:** Ms. Walker gave a short presentation, as Council had received a Booklet 2020-2021 Town of Mammoth Proposed Budget and the Schedules for the same. The Adoptive Budget was announced at \$5,300,411.00
This includes the Property Tax Levy at \$51,586.00 which allows you to reduce the rate from 2.2045 to 2.0251 per \$100 of assessed value, due to the fact that the assessed values went up from 2.3 Million to 2.5 Million. This will allow you to keep the same tax levy which will allow property taxes to remain the same. This budget also includes the Arizona Cares Act Monies at \$193,679.00 that you should see deposited in the next week. We will discuss the applications of these monies at a future meeting. You all received the budget packet earlier in the week and I would be happy to answer any questions at this time. We have published all required documents, including all public notices. We are now ready for the adoption of the Final Budget 2020-2021.
Councilwoman Martinez: The tax rate is going down but the Property Tax Monies Received will be the same, is that correct?
Pat Walker: Yes, that is correct.
