

Attached is my version of the Swimming Pool Management Agreement Extension. It is the same exact agreement that was signed in June 2021, except that it is an extension. Once you are OK with the language, let me know and I will drop off 2 signed copies to Town Hall.

I am recommending that the 2021 Swim Season go through October 31, 2021, just in case we get some crazy warm Fall weather, however, public swim will most likely end on Friday, October 1, 2021 due to the water temperature being too cold for the lap swimmers.

If for some reason this agreement will NOT be on the August Meeting Agenda, please let me know ASAP so that we can start getting our stuff out of the pool and be gone on August 15.

If the agreement extension will be on the August Agenda, please send me something in writing, before August 15, assuring me that the Town of Mammoth will honor the existing agreement through August 21, 2021. If the agreement extension is NOT approved on August 19, I will work through August 21, 2021 (assuming you agree). All our stuff will be out of the pool by August 22, 2021.

If the agreement extension is approved, and the Town of Mammoth wants to purchase their own solar pool covers for this fall and for next year, please let me know. The cost will be approximately \$1400. The solar pool covers need to be cut and fused to fit the pool. The Sea Lions Swim Team will make the covers and will donate cover rollers if the Town chooses to go this route. Alternatively, the Sea Lions can provide the covers but we will take them with us when we leave in October.

OPTION 1: Pool Schedule (Assuming the agreement extension is NOT on the August Agenda)

- Adult Lap Swim ends Friday August 13, 2021 (The Town can choose to continue Lap Swim after August 13 with their own lifeguards. Please note that there will be no lane lines, since we will take our lines with us. Covers will be needed to extend lap swim past mid-September.)
- Sunday Family Swim ends Sunday August 15, 2021 (The Town can choose to continue Sunday Family Swim after August 15 with their own lifeguards)
- There is a paid Pool Party scheduled for Saturday August 21, 2021 – We will have to decide what the Town wants to do about Lifeguards for this party
- There is a tentative Pool Party scheduled for Saturday August 28, 2021 – We will have to decide what the Town wants to do about lifeguards for this party, if it happens

OPTION 2: Pool Schedule (Assuming the agreement extension is NOT approved on 8/19/21)

- Adult Lap Swim ends Friday August 20, 2021 (The Town can choose to continue Lap Swim after August 20 with their own lifeguards. There will be no lane lines. Covers will be needed to extend lap swim past mid-September.)
- Sunday Family Swim ends Sunday August 15, 2021 (The Town can choose to continue Sunday Family Swim after August 15 with their own lifeguards)
- The Sea Lions will provide lifeguards for the pool party on August 21, 2021 since it is already scheduled and paid for
- The Town will have to provide lifeguards for the pool party on August 28, 2021 if it happens

OPTION 3: Pool Schedule (Assuming the agreement extension is approved on 8/19/21)

- Adult Lap Swim ends Friday October 1, 2021 (or until people stop coming because the water is too cold)
- Sunday Family Swim will be extended until people stop coming – usually this is mid-to-late August
- Lifeguards will be provided for all pool parties

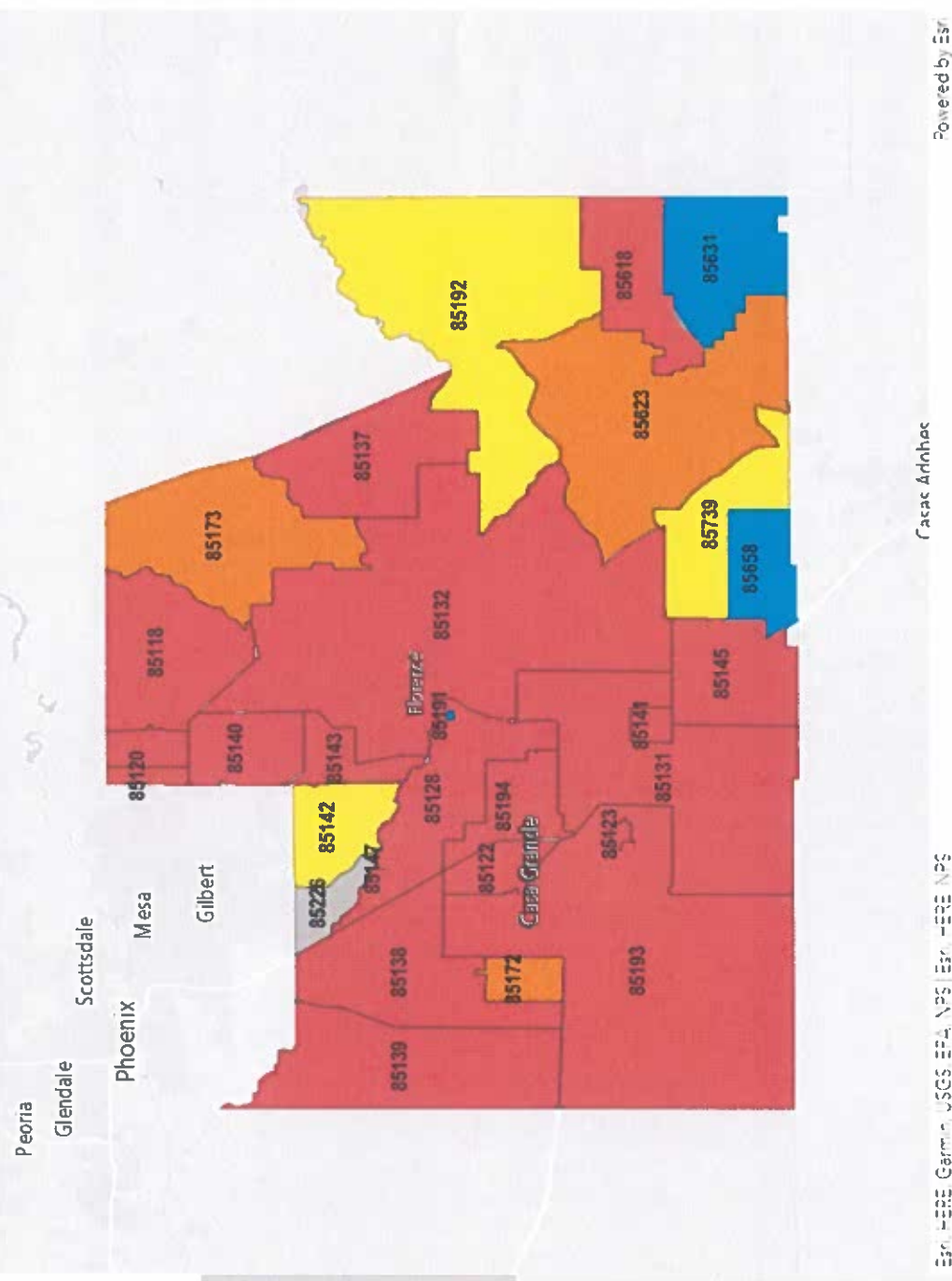
